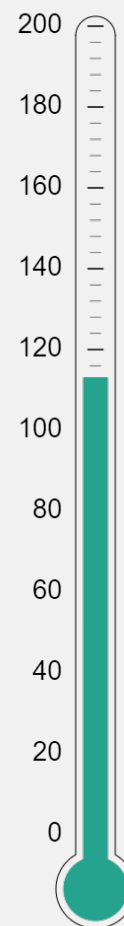
## RECRUITMENT UPDATE

## SAFETY PEARL

An eligible patient is one who:

- 1) is 18 years of age or older;
- 2) has been diagnosed with a primary extremity high-grade soft-tissue sarcoma (STS);
- 3) has undergone surgical excision of the tumor for curative intent;
- 4) has completed all treatment (ex. radiation, chemotherapy);
- 5) has a tumor greater than or equal to five centimeters;
- 6) provides informed consent; and
- 7) does not meet any of the exclusion criteria (please refer to the Screening Form)

**All patients who meet the first three criteria should be screened.** If they do not meet all three criteria, then you do not need to complete a Screening Form for them.

We aim to have the results of the SAFETY Trial be applicable to a wide range of extremity STS patients, so **if a tumor is just under five centimeters (e.g., 4.7-4.9), please contact us to confirm eligibility to potentially enroll the patient.**

## SAFETY PEARL

The SAFETY Trial protocol and case report forms (CRFs) were recently updated to versions 3.0 and 6.0, respectively. The CRF update includes additional income brackets in Q10 of the Baseline Characteristics Form. If patients previously selected "Less than 20,000" or "100,000 or more," **please have them select from the updated income brackets at their next visit.**
