## SAFETY Pearls (Site Q & A)

### How do I calculate follow-up appointments?

All surveillance visits should be calculated using the Randomization Date specified on the **Randomization Form (Form 2)**. The date of surgery should not be used to calculate surveillance visits. Please use the **Participant Visit Window Calculator** provided to calculate the acceptable time window. If you require a new or customized calculator, please contact Tess ([hudsonstc@mcmaster.ca](mailto:hudsonstc@mcmaster.ca)) at the Methods Centre.

### Can I enroll a patient with indeterminate nodules?

Provided the indeterminate nodules are followed and determined to be stable, such patients can be enrolled in the SAFETY trial. Please use Q3 on the **Baseline Thoracic Imaging Report Form (Form 3)**, which asks whether indeterminate nodules were found, the number of nodules, and whether they were determined to be stable.
