RECRUITMENT UPDATE

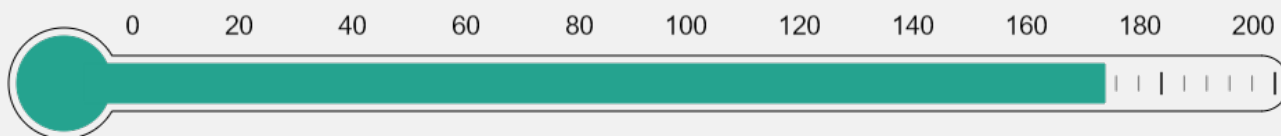
We are pleased to report that as of 13 October 2022, **170** participants have been enrolled in the SAFETY trial.

SAFETY UPDATES

PATIENT CANCER CARE COSTS DIARY

The Cost Diary is required at **every intervention visit**. If a patient incurs minimal or no costs related to their cancer diagnosis, please have them report this on the Cost Diary.

In iDataFax, empty pages of the Costs Diary do not need to be completed – they are only for additional data.

Please remember that Question 13 of the Costs Diary has a spot for patients to include unpaid assistance. Other common costs include hospital parking, gas, physiotherapy, wound care materials (e.g., bandages, gauze, etc.), and over-the-counter medications.

Tip: Bring an extra copy of the Cost Diary to the appointment in case the patient does not bring their copy or have the patient complete the form electronically at home. Fillable PDF questionnaires can be found [here](#).

SCREENING PATIENTS

Please screen all patients who are 18 years of age or older, have a grade II or III STS, and have undergone surgery. Screening Forms for included, excluded, and missed participants must be entered into the iDataFax EDC system. JURAVINSKI HOSPITAL AND CANCER CENTRE ENROLMENT CAP

SYSTEMIC AND RADIATION LOGS

Please complete the systemic and/or radiation logs for any neoadjuvant or adjuvant therapies at the baseline visit. It should also be completed for any therapies the patient is receiving for any systemic or local recurrence, or for any other types of cancer the patient may be diagnosed with (ex. prostate, breast, etc.).

Please note that each day or cycle of the treatment should **not** be reported on the form separately. Please enter the start and stop dates of the entire treatment regimen.

For multi-drug regimens (e.g., AIM), please report each drug as a separate entry in the Systemic Therapy Log.
